


Thursday, August 28 · 5:30 PM

PHYSICALS

Physicals

All students planning to participate in any **high school sport** during the upcoming school year must have a current physical on file. **Physicals are valid for 12 months**, so we strongly encourage families to complete this during the summer to ensure eligibility for all sports throughout the year.

We are pleased to partner with Exer Urgent Care, which is offering free sports physicals to all Hillcrest athletes. While you are not required to use Exer, this is a convenient and cost-effective option—especially for those who may have already completed a physical within the past year but would like to align it with the school year. Taking care of this now helps prevent any disruptions to your child's participation in practices or games during the season.


ELIGIBILITY/CLEARANCE

Eligibility / Clearance

To be eligible to participate in any sport during the 2025–2026 school year—including High School Girls Volleyball and Football, which begin in July—all student-athletes must be registered and cleared through www.homecampus.com/clearances.

The clearance process includes entering medical and emergency contact information, as well as completing a series of required forms to be signed by both a parent/guardian and the student-athlete. This clearance must be completed before any student may participate in practices, tryouts, or games.

Please plan ahead to ensure your athlete is fully cleared before their season begins.


Fall Sports Begin August
